SUBJECT: Extension of Approval of Opti-Blast Type II Plastic Media

1. The Air Force Corrosion Prevention and Control Office has the responsibility for maintaining the list of qualified suppliers conforming to MIL-DTL-85891B under a joint Memorandum of Agreement with all federal organizations. First article testing was completed in April 2020, and results indicated a necessity to update MIL-DTL-85891B requirements.
2. In the interim, this letter is provided to Opti-Blast to indicate that their Type II engineered media is **approved** for use until **June 2022** unless removed earlier for non-conformance. At that time, results for completed MIL-DTL-85891B qualification testing will be made available to Opti-Blast and the US Government for determination of conformance or failure to the updated MIL-DTL-85891B specification. Conformance will allow addition to the MIL-DTL-85891B Qualified Products Database (QPD). Failure to qualify will be sufficient justification for removal from T.O. 1-1-8 and/or the MIL-DTL-85891B QPD. Our office has forwarded your extension to the MIL-P-85891A list of qualified suppliers by email to the General Services Administration with the same date as your letter. As a note, the effective date of the extension began 1 July 2021.
